

1. Create a dedicated folder somewhere safe and copy the following:
 - a. Actions
 - b. Automate (C:\Program Files\Adobe\Adobe Photoshop CS3\Plug-Ins\Automate)
 - c. Displacement Maps (C:\Program Files\Adobe\Adobe Photoshop CS3\Plug-Ins\Displacement Maps)
 - d. File Formats (C:\Program Files\Adobe\Adobe Photoshop CS3\Plug-Ins\File Formats)
 - e. Filters (C:\Program Files\Adobe\Adobe Photoshop CS3\Plug-Ins\Filters)
 - f. Fonts (C:\Program Files\Common Files\Adobe\Fonts)
 - g. Plugins (your own custom path, check screen #9 in the under Preferences for plugin location)
 - h. Work Spaces (C:\Documents and Settings\%Username%\Application Data\Adobe\Adobe Photoshop CS3\Adobe Photoshop CS3 Settings\WorkSpaces)
2. Run the deauthorization/removal routines for any 3rd party plugins or software add-ons to Photoshop (i.e. OnOne, Topaz Laps, Noise Ninja, Photomatix, PTGui Pano, etc.)
3. Deauthorize Photoshop
4. Uninstall Photoshop on computer 1 and re-install on computer 2
5. Re-install plugins, automation software and other 3rd party add-ons after re-install.
6. Copy above referenced files and folders back to the new source locations for Photoshop
7. Adjust preferences and settings to mirror your previous setup from screen captures.
